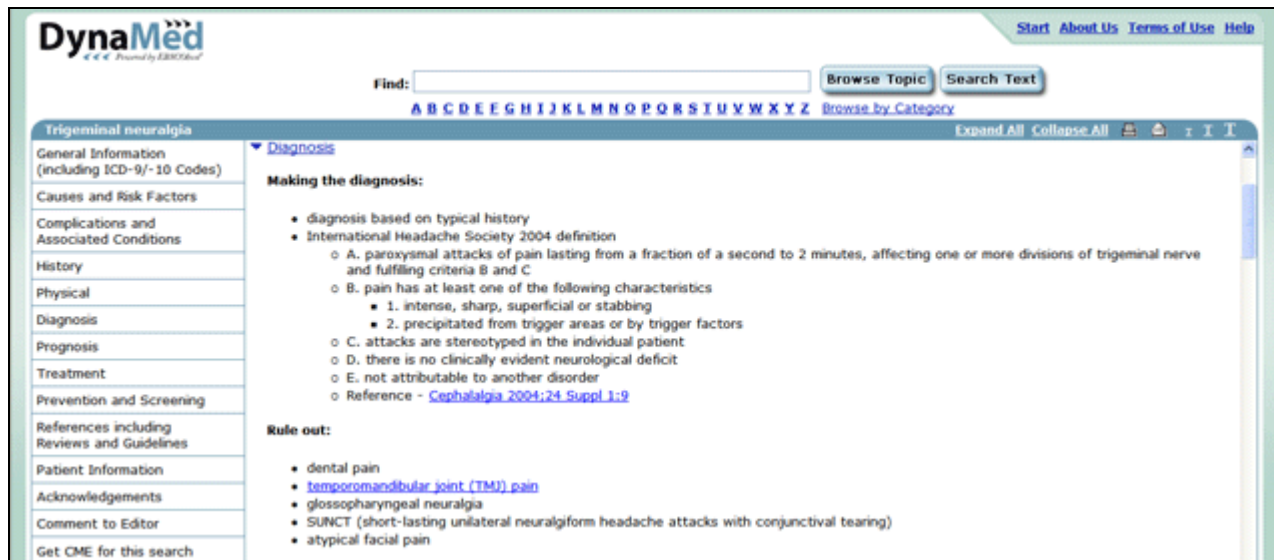


Viewing Information within a Topic

DynaMed uses industry-standard headings to assist users in finding topics and categories of information. Information on diseases is written conclusion first to assist users in finding critical information. Section headers are the same for every DynaMed topic and are always presented in the same order:

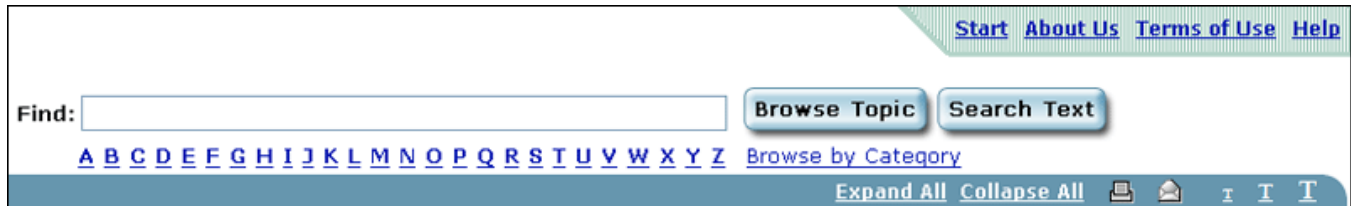
- General Information (including ICD-9/-10 codes)
- Causes and Risk Factors
- Complications and Associated Conditions
- History
- Physical
- Diagnosis
- Prognosis
- Treatment
- Prevention and Screening
- References (including Reviews and Guidelines)
- Patient Information
- Acknowledgements



- Click the **Expand All** link (located in the top right corner of the View Screen) to simultaneously open all sections within a Topic.
- Click the **Collapse All** link (located in the top right corner of the View Screen) to simultaneously close all sections within a Topic.
- When viewing content within a specific section, click any **Section Header** in the left navigation bar to jump to the detail of another section.
- To search for text on the DynaMed page you are viewing, press **Control-F** on your keyboard and enter a term in the browser's **Find** text box.
- Click a **Reference** link within the Topic detail to view credible supporting reference materials.
- Level of Evidence labels, e.g. Level 1 (likely reliable) evidence, can be found within the Treatment section of each Topic.

Sizing Text in the View Screen

The top right corner of the View Screen contains three T icons that allow you to adjust the size of the text displayed in the View Screen. Clicking any of **T icons** dynamically changes the size of the text on the screen.



Printing and E-mailing

When viewing a Topic or Category, the top right corner of the View Screen contains a Print and E-Mail icon. Clicking either the **Print** or the **E-mail** icon displays prompts that guide you through the Print or E-mail process.



Recently Updated

The Recently Updated item located in the left navigation bar allows you to view information about recent content updates made to DynaMed. Clicking **Recently Updated** displays a Result List of updated topics. Each item includes the date, time, and details of the update.
